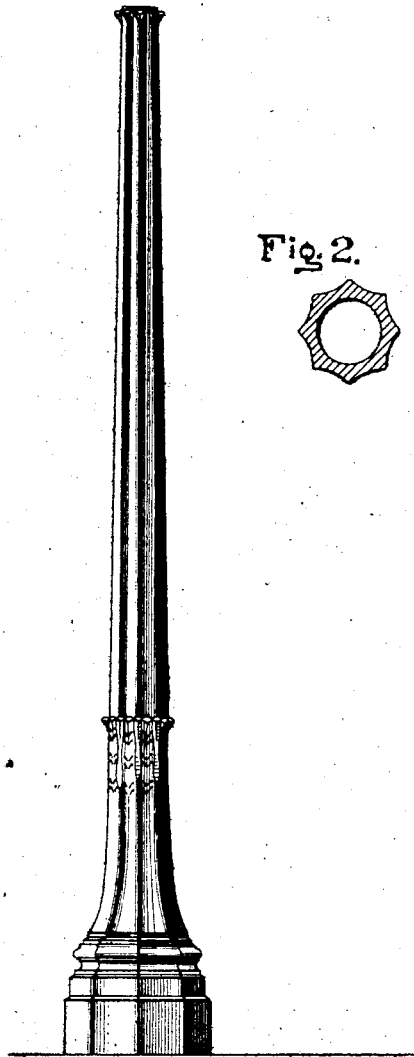
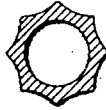

DESIGN FOR AN UPRIGHT FOR A LIGHTING UNIT.

Application filed May 11, 1923. Serial No. 6,138. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOSEPH W. GOSLING, a citizen of the United States, residing at Schenectady, in the county of Schenectady, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Upright for a Lighting Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

The accompanying drawing shows in Fig. 1 a front elevation of my ornamental upright for a lighting unit; Fig. 2 is a cross section thereof.
