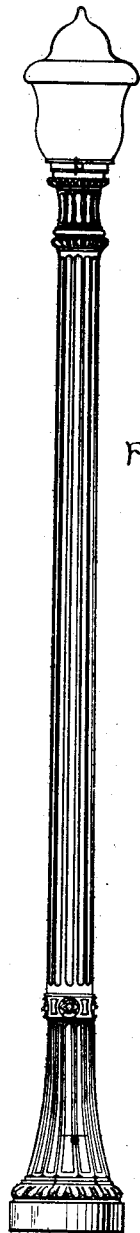

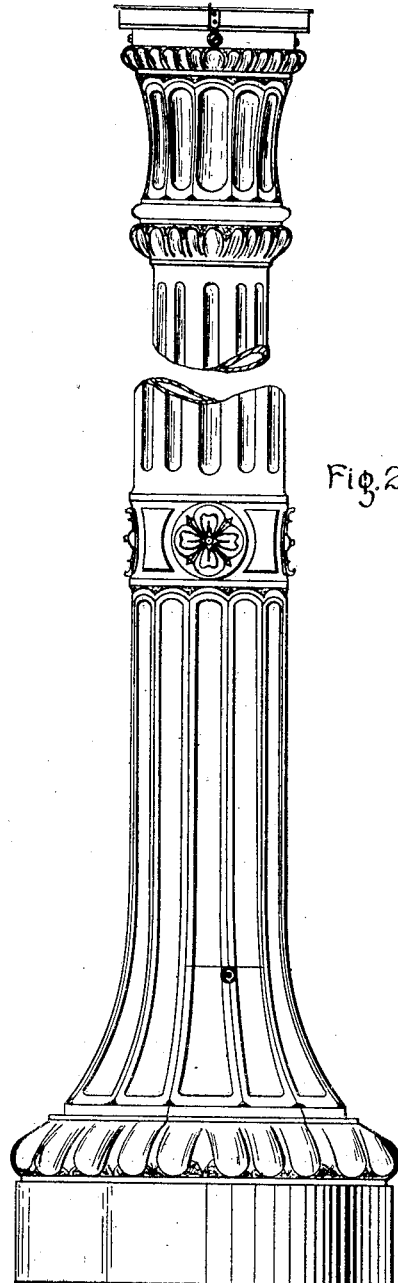

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING STANDARD.

Application filed July 13, 1922. Serial No. 3,065. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN R. TOWNSEND, a citizen of the United States, residing at South Bend, in the county of St. Joseph and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lighting Standards, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, constituting a part hereof.

Figure 1 is an elevational view of my new design of lighting standard having a conventional form of globe thereon, and

Fig. 2 is an enlarged detail view of my lighting standard, the central portion thereof being broken away.

I claim:

An ornamental design for a lighting standard as shown.
