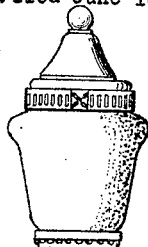

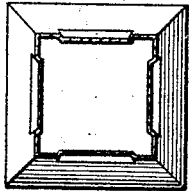

WILLIAM DILL, OF RUSHVILLE, INDIANA.

DESIGN FOR A LAMP-POST.

Application filed June 16, 1925. Serial No. 13,795. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM DILL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Rushville, in the county of Rush and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Lamp-Posts, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a

lamp post showing my new design. Figure 2 is a cross section taken on line 2—2 of Figure 1, and Figure 3 is a cross section taken on line 3—3 of Figure 1 in the direction in which the arrows point.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a lamp post substantially as shown.
