

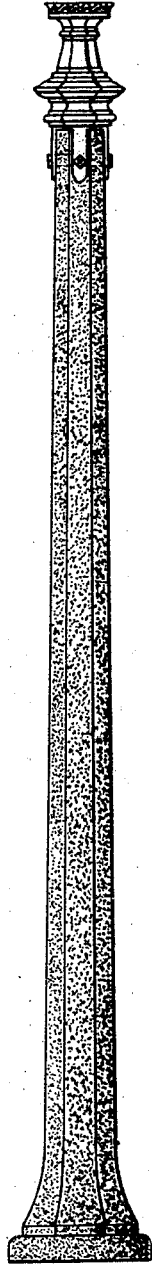

DESIGN FOR A LAMP STANDARD.

To all whom it may concern:
