

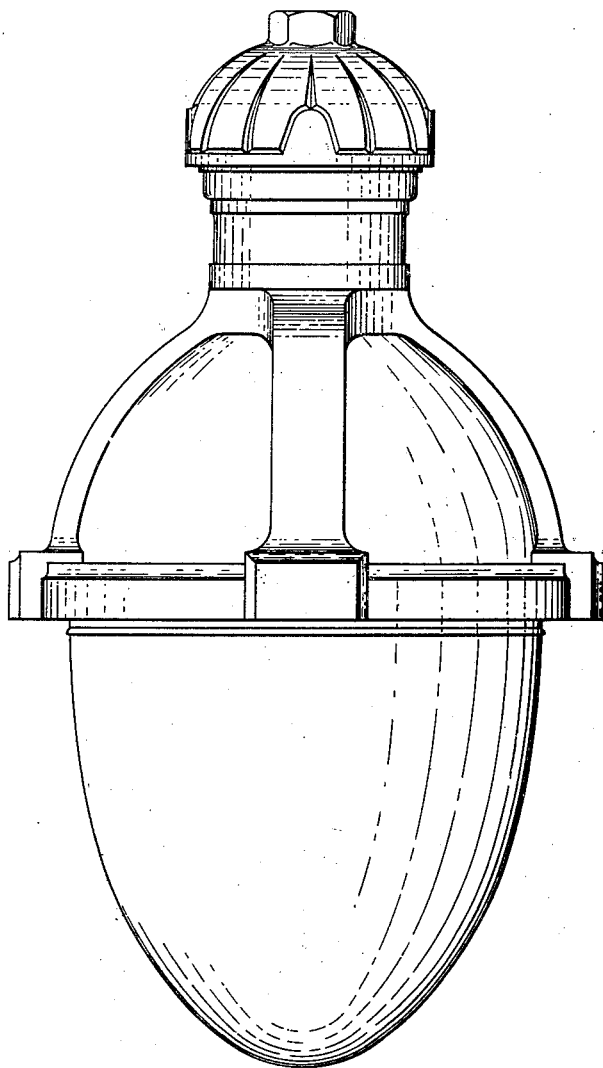

DESIGN FOR A LIGHTING UNIT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Carl F. Haas, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting Unit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof. The single

figure is a side elevational view of a lighting unit embodying my new design. The opposite sides of the unit are substantially the same in appearance as the side disclosed.
