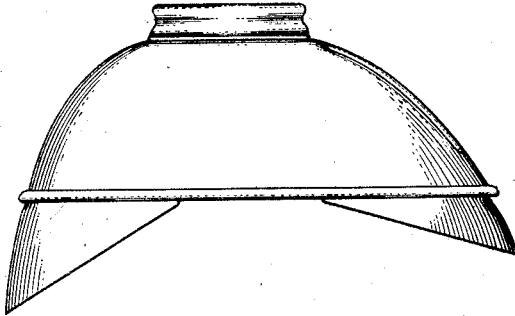

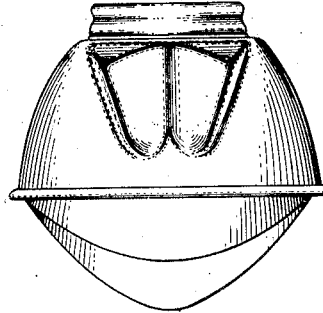

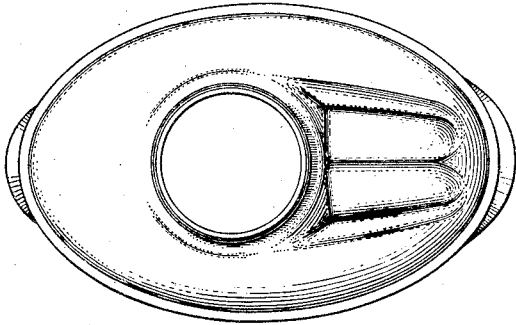

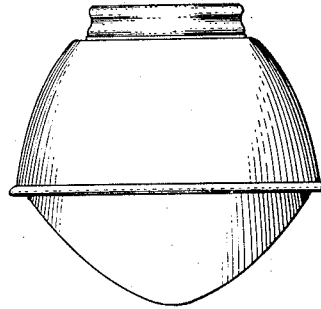
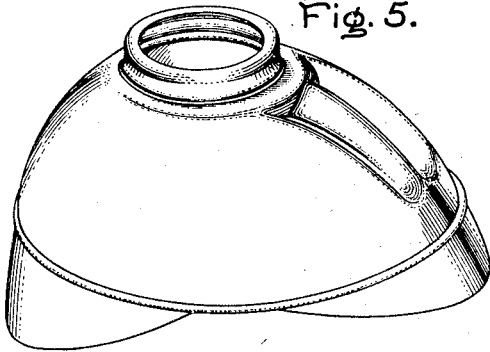

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles H. Rex, a citizen of the United States, residing at 30 Birch Street, Marblehead, in the county of Essex, State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Street Lighting Reflector, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing, Fig. 1 is a plan view, Fig. 2 is a side elevational view, Fig. 3 is an end elevational view as seen from the right of Fig. 1, Fig. 4 is an end elevational view as seen from the left of Fig. 1, and Fig. 5 is a perspective view of the street lighting reflector embodying my invention.
